Club Fertiliser

The club sells a slow release fertiliser which is generally suitable for growing orchids, however like most commercial chemicals it is not produced for orchids only or your growing conditions in particular. There is no 'one size fits all' you have to observe what happens without being paranoid about it. The recommended rate for this fertiliser (Plantacote Pluss 6M) is approx. ½ teaspoon spread evenly over the outer edges of a 100mm pot. The release rates depend upon soil temperature. With an average soil temperature of 20/21degrees C the release rate is 5-6 months. Further information can be obtained from Bev Heidke or the manufacturer.
