BOSI Autumn Show – there will be daily raffles with 1st, 2nd and 3rd prizes each day the show is open to the public. In addition, there will be a 3-day raffle with the major prize being a crochet jacket donated by Gerry Brookes, plus an orchid plant. Gerry has also donated hand-made soaps which will also be used as a minor prize in this raffle. Alwyn reminded members that we need more volunteers to sell entry tickets and raffle tickets at the show. We also need more people to sell posies. Bev needs plant names by no later than 6th May and labels can be collected from her on Tuesday morning, or at the Show. Please ensure your hands are clean and dry when handling barcoded labels, as smudged barcodes are unreadable. The Civic Centre will be open from 7.00am on Thursday 9th for set-up. Members should bring their plants from about 8.30-9.00 am. All club plants to be benched by 1.00pm on Thursday. Alwyn then gave a very informative talk about preparing plants for the show, including lighting conditions for optimal flowering, labelling, cleanliness and presentation of plants and pots for benching. John Hughes explained that even an exceptional orchid can be outclassed by a mediocre specimen if it is not presented correctly. He then proceeded to give a practical demonstration of how to set up flowers and plants to catch the judges' eye.
